2019 Summer Camp Inclusion Supervisor

Sunset Community Centre is accepting applications from qualified individuals available to work as an Inclusion Supervisor who will ensure that camps are accessible to all children regardless of ability level.

The Inclusion Supervisor will report to the respective camp Supervisors and Summer Day Camp Project Manager. This is a direct leadership role.

Camp runs from July 2-August 23, Monday to Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm. This position will take place at Sunset Community Centre.

Responsibilities:

- Working as part of the staff team to modify and adapt activities and out trips to ensure successful participation by all campers; to provide alternative activities from small groups as necessary
- Develop positive relationships among the various members of the day camp with an emphasis on the 10% of children requiring additional support
- Supporting children with disabilities to be actively involved in a community setting
- Maintain regular and respectful contact with parents and guardians of participants
- Lead in training, orientation, mentoring, and evaluation of volunteers assisting with the camps

Qualifications & Experience:

- Experience working with children and youth (ages 6-16) in a recreational setting with emphasis on working with people with disabilities
- Excellent communication, leadership, problem-solving and interpersonal skills
- Valid first aid and CPR is mandatory and a second language is an asset
- Ability to work independently and within a team, and can make appropriate decisions as needed
- Clearance of a Police Record Check

To be eligible to participate in the Canada Summer Jobs initiative, individuals must:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations
